Winter Solstice Bus Trip December 17, 2011

- * We board a heated, chartered bus (at 8:30) and travel through snow-laden forests, craggy mountains, iced streams, over Snoqualmie and Blewett Passes to the beautiful Bavarian Christmas village—Leavenworth;
- * We stop for sledding and snow play or walks in the woods at Blewett Pass;
- * At the Eagle Creek Ranch, just outside of Leavenworth, we take a horse-drawn sleigh ride, returning to their lodge for dinner, before re-boarding the bus;
- * We stop in Leavenworth for the lights, shopping, enjoying a warm fire with local musicians playing in the square and more!
- * We stop at Blewett Pass and have a brief candlelight solstice ritual and join in hope for peace and light;
- * Lastly, we re-board our bus for the journey home; arriving back at the Eastgate Park and Ride lot around 11:00 PM.
